Food Distribution Locations

Monday - Thursday, 10 am - 4 pm - Dayton Food Pantry located on Enterprise Way

3rd Saturday of every month - Sutro Elementary School - 12 pm - 3 pm

Holiday Season

Each November and December we see our numbers go up at our monthly distribution day as well as our pantry location. From November 21st - December 31st we distributed 501 boxes of food through our monthly distribution day and 1050 emergency boxes of food through our pantry location. In addition to the turkeys and whole chickens, we purchase extra canned and dry food in anticipation of the increased numbers.

Example:

Food purchased with donations in November and December 2015

400 turkeys
200 whole roaster chickens
129 cases of assorted canned goods
1020 packages of pasta
432 bags of cereal
350 bags of rice

Cooking Classes
