

Spring Into Action


Warmer-Weather Tips for Loving Where You Live.

Bring those hardier plants outside when it starts to get nice, and determine which ones need to be repotted. And consider faux metal succulents and agave plants that come in all sizes."

"Make sure there is no water leaking because it could be an indication of a faulty water or sprinkler pipe," he says.

Shaun Klein, director of business development for Nova Tile and Stone with locations in Reno, Minden, Fernley, and Sacramento, suggests that with the extra moisture and mud that come with spring, replacing flooring with luxury vinyl plank flooring is a great idea for a sustainable, sleek entryway.

"LVP is a great option in houses because there are many styles and colors, and it's ideal for those who want the look of wood without the added hassle," Klein notes. "It can be used in those wet spaces for contiguous flooring from bathrooms, hallways, and doorways to open spaces. Should they ever get damaged, you can replace the planks on LVP easily. For tile, we use an epoxy-based grout that doesn't absorb moisture, maintains consistency of color, and doesn't expand or contract. We can find the best solution to handle soggy rainboots and wetness without damaging the look of your flooring."
